Did You Know? By Joanne Westman

The space currently occupied by the Dexter Senior Center (DSC) has a long history. The first building, called the Dexter Union School, was built in 1857. That building was torn down and replaced in 1887 with a beautiful brick building complete with bell tower. In 1936, an addition was built and the name was changed to the Dexter Agricultural School, the building we knew as Copeland School (now Encore Theater).

The old Union School was torn down in the late 50’s. At that time, a wing was added to the new Dexter Agricultural School to house a shop class. In the mid 1960’s, the shop was later remodeled to house four kindergarten classes. It is that space the Dexter Senior Center now occupies. Two of our DSC members, Jeanette Ennis and Rosemary Quigley, taught at Copeland, Rosemary in the grade school and Jeanette in the kindergarten. Member Suzanne VanNatter attended grade school at Copeland and her four children started kindergarten in the very room that is now the Senior Center.

A long and fascinating history indeed!
